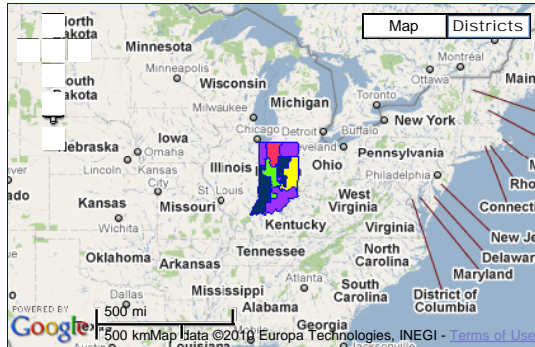

- a) Congressional Deadline: April 29, 2011 (end of first regular session)
- Basis for Deadline: [Ind. Code § 3-3-2](#)
- Effect of Failure to Meet Deadline: Redistricting Commission adopts an interim plan.
- b) Legislative Deadline: April 29, 2011
- Basis for Deadline: Statute
- Effect of Failure to Meet Deadline: Special session of the General Assembly, if called by the Governor.
