In case you didn't know, water is now the official drink of the State of Indiana and Interior Designers are on their way to being registered by the State. All of this while All Day Kindergarten and paper trails for electronic voting systems languish in committee. This is the last week that bills will have a chance to be heard and make it to third reading.

This is what remains of the legislative calendar:

- April 10<sup>th</sup> - last day for 3<sup>rd</sup> reading of Senate bills in the House
- April 11<sup>th</sup> - last day for 3<sup>rd</sup> reading of House bills in the Senate
- April 11<sup>th</sup> - last day for House adoption of conference committee reports without Rules Committee approval
- April 11<sup>th</sup> - last day for Senate adoption of conference committee reports without Rules Committee approval
- April 29<sup>th</sup> - Adjournment
