

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE April 9 thru April 13, 2007

It's over, April 11th was the last day for 3rd reading of bills in the Senate and the last day for House and Senate adoption of conference committee reports without Rules Committee approval.

Thanks to the local leagues for sending President Joanne Evers, *Letter to the Editor*, to your local papers asking the legislature to provide funding for All Day Kindergarten. The letter appeared in the Indianapolis Star and two papers in Montgomery County.

There are 14 days remaining before the Indiana General Assembly must adjourn on April 29th. There is significant legislation in House-Senate conference committees awaiting action by law-makers. The issues include the biennial budget, property tax relief, school funding including full-day kindergarten, local government consolidation, health care and gambling (now playing a key role in funding the budget). Please watch your local papers and television for outcomes.
