VOTE ABSENTEE BY MAIL

The League of Women Voters of Greater Lafayette would like to encourage all voters to apply for an absentee ballot for the Indiana Primary Election now to be held on June 2. The State of Indiana has relaxed the criteria to apply for the mail in ballot due to the health risk large crowds may pose at this time.

However, voting must go on and you can still exercise your right to vote by applying for an absentee ballot through the Tippecanoe County website at www.tippecanoe.in.gov/447/Absentee-Voting, by emailing the election board at electionboard@tippecanoe.in.gov or calling 423-9316. The new deadline to request the ballot is May 21. (This date needs to be confirmed)

Once you have your ballot you can still research the candidates through the Leagues' on-line voters guide at VOTE411.org. Candidates for federal, state, and local offices are participating to provide you will information about their candidacy and where they stand on multiple issues. Be an informed voter and check out VOTE411. It will be available to the public on March 30.
